### ACTIVITIES

Camp James Ray does not have a campsite big enough for the entire troop; therefore the troop will be camping on two campsites. The Badger, Moose, and Shark patrols will be on the Navaho campsite and the Pyro, Pedro, and Fox will be on the Cherokee campsite. The adults will be split between the two sites. These two sites are next to each other.

For water-skiing and water activities the troop will be divided into 2 groups. Group 1 will be the scouts in the TFC program and troop guides. Group 2 will be all other scouts.

The water activities will be water skiing, tubing and canoeing. If you would like to have water wars, the scouts need to bring water guns, water balloons will be provided.

Water Safety—In order to participate in the water skiing, tubing, or canoeing you must pass the swim test. If you passed the swim test at summer camp, or you completed either the swimming or life saving merit badges within the last year, then you will not have to take the swim test at the camp.

### DIRECTIONS TO CAMP JAMES RAY PREVIOUSLY NAMED CAMP GRAYSON

1. Go North on Highway 75 approximately 56 miles to exit 69 (FM 120)
2. Turn Left (west) onto FM 120 go 5.2 miles to Pottsboro
3. On the west side of Pottsboro take FM 996 4.3 miles to Cooks Corner Rd.
4. FM 996 becomes Cooks Corner Rd. go 1 mile to Locust Rd
5. Turn left onto Locust Rd and go 1.6 miles to Mill Creek Rd.
6. Turn right onto Mill Creek Road Rd and look for Camp James Ray Sign (less than 1/10 mile)
